

Plan Now for I-69 Construction on IU Gamedays

Construction is currently underway to add two sections to Interstate 69. Section 4 runs from U.S. 231 near Crane NSWC/NSA to S.R. 37 south of Bloomington. Section 5 runs from S.R. 37 south of Bloomington along existing S.R. 37 to the S.R. 39 interchange just south of Martinsville.

During construction, lane restrictions are expected, which may add to your travel time on game days. Section 4 is expected to open fully to traffic in 2015; Section 5 in 2016. ... Read more.
